CHILDREN'S & YOUTH

COACHING IN THE GAME LEVEL THREE

In both Children's and Youth Awards Structures, the 12-hour Coaching in the Game Certificate Course looks at the knowledge and understanding required to help young players appreciate concepts such as width, depth and support within the small-sided game. The course is largely practical in nature and prospective coaches are required to demonstrate the ability to coach basic strategies to young players.

Applicants must have completed a Level Two course.

Comprising of 2 practical components consisting of Coaching Young Footballers and Technique Development, it is a prerequisite for candidates wishing to enrol on the Level 5 Advanced Children's Licence. Applicants must have completed the Early Touches, Coaching Young Footballers and Coaching in the Game courses.

This 30-hour non-residential qualification assesses competence in delivering a coaching session based on the format of the Coaching Youth/Adult Course. In addition, candidates will be required to demonstrate the ability to shape a team and structure an individual programme for youth players. Applicants must have completed the Development Activities, Coaching Youth Footballers and Coaching In The Game courses.
